

Excursion Marble Caves (3 days / 2 nights)

The "Capillas de Mármol" (Marble chapels or caves) are a group of strange, but incredibly beautiful rock formations located in the General Carrera Lake and are one of the best known attractions of the Carretera Austral.

Declared sanctuaries, the Marble Caves are calcium carbonate formations which over the years have been eroded by the waters of the General Carrera Lake, creating islets which are navigable on small boats.

Departure Days: Thursday and Saturday (January - April; September – December)

Day 1

- Departure from Hotel Loberías del Sur or Balmaceda Airport (**)
- Excursion to Capillas de Mármol
- Dinner and accommodation at Parador Loberías del Sur in Puerto Bertrand (beverages not included)

Day 2

- Breakfast at Parador Loberías del Sur Puerto in Bertrand
- Free day, lunch at the lodge (beverages not included)
- Dinner and accommodation at Parador Loberías del Sur in Puerto Bertrand (beverages not included)

Day 3

- Breakfast at Lodge
- Check out
- Transfer from Lodge to Balmaceda airport (***) or Coyhaique or Puerto Chacabuco

(*) Navigation can be done on either of the two days depending on weather conditions, preferably the first day.

(**) When the program begins at the Balmaceda Airport, it must be combined with the first flight arriving in the morning.

(***) When the program ends at the Balmaceda Airport, you must do so to connect with the last flight in the afternoon.
